Before the Tour

 Read Sections 1-6 of <u>The Wisconsin Public Library Standards</u>, <u>6th Edition</u> OR Sections 1-6 of <u>The Inclusive Services Assessment and Guide for Wisconsin Public Libraries</u>.

Only choose one document! Each is about 30 pages.

2. Depending on which document you choose, read the following 3 questions.

Wisconsin Public Library Standards

- 1. Use the <u>Wisconsin Public Library Standards Checklist</u>, and choose a couple of lines to discuss with an employee at the library. Reflect on the conversation and tell us about it.
- 2. Using the quantitative standards on pages 28-30, where does the library fall in terms of periodical holdings and number of computers? How do you feel about these standards?
- 3. Take a look at the tier three standards. Which are most/least attainable for a library of this size? Why?

The Inclusive Services Assessment and Guide for Wisconsin Public Libraries

- 1. Review the Inclusive Services Statement in Section 1. What comes up for you after reading this? Try to be specific with your answer.
- 2. Using Section 4, What the Library Has to Offer, what did you notice about the library's collections?
- 3. Using Section 5, Where the Interactions Take Place, what did you notice about the facility in terms of inclusivity?
